1. Application Form. Fill out completely and have an official of the Union verify membership.
2. Statement of Goals. Prepare a concise essay (300 words) on the "Importance of Union Commitment in America."
3. Letters of Recommendation. Obtain letters of recommendation from two persons who are in a position to evaluate your ability, performance, and potential for success in college. These persons must be outside your family.
4. Transcript and GPA. Obtain an official copy of your high school and/or college transcript and your grade point average (to date).
5. This scholarship is \$500.00 each year for a maximum for four years. This money will be sent directly to the recipient.
6. Submit all information to the Union Business Office by July 1, 2022.

ASBESTOS WORKERS' SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The law firm of Koonz McKenney Johnson & DePaolis is pleased to announce the 37th year of the Asbestos Workers' Scholarship Fund for children, grandchildren, and spouses of Local #24 members. Each year two entrants will be awarded a four-year scholarship, totaling \$2,000 for college tuition and related expenses.

The fund will be administered by Peter C. DePaolis from the law firm and the business agent from the Union. Each year two entrants will be awarded the scholarship based upon academic achievement, community service, and the evaluation of a brief essay on the importance of unions in today's society.

All children, grandchildren, and spouses of active members of the Union will be eligible as long as they are currently in their senior year of high school or are enrolled in a college on either a full or part-time basis. Application forms will require letters of recommendation, high school transcripts, SAT or equivalent scores, and an essay of at least 300 words. The topic to be addressed in the essay will be "The Importance of Union Commitment in America."
